Introduction

Nisarg Vidyan Mandal (NiViM)Nagpur conducted overall developmental programs for the tribal belt of forest prone villages on the Muniya Conservation Reserve (MCR) to avoid Man-Animal conflict by implementation of a sustainable agriculture practices with conservation Indian indigenous breed of cows. This practice is started from 2008 and its continue through our people participated project NETRAVAN (i.e Nature science Education, Training and Research for resilience in Agro forestry adventures through Voluntary Action Networks) at Khapari (Davha), Ta: Umrer, Dist :Nagpur. Thrust areas of overall development are Forest protection, Water shed management ,wildlife conservation, natural /organic farming for sustainable livelihood of marginal poor stakeholders of rural area. Social awareness and action programs, skills development training to make Gomay products for income generation by rural tribal women ,cattle owner ,animal lover and marginal poor farmers were organised during year financial year 2020-2021.

NiViM also working in urban area of Nagpur in particular to inculcate green thoughts amongst young enthusiastic graduate students interested in competative examination to become administrator in future. NiViM started Dnyandip Abhyasika cum Library of useful for examination of MPSC, UPSC,STI,Banking at NeelKamal Housing Cooperative society , Besa ,Nagpur

Nisarg Vidnayan Mandal (NiViM) is working voluntarily to strengthen the capacity of poor marginal farmers farmers to get them sustainable livelihood by avoiding Man-animal conflict in the forest corridor of Muniya Reserve Forest(MRF) in Umred taluk of Nagpur district. NiViM formed a group of farmers have agriculture land on the fringe of MRF. Recently, It is an area of 9601 Hac(i.e.96.01 Sq.Km) notified as Muniya Conservation Reserve by Govt of Maharashtra on Dec,4th 2020.This notification is result NiViMs continuous follow up to proper management of wild life in the forest and agriculture land by farmers to avoid Mananimal conflict. NiViM organised trainings for farmers from seven

villagesd registereec as a member of Alternative Farming Club(AFC). It registered under ATMA scheme of Agriculture department of Govt. Of Maharashtra. Trainings for preparation of Organic Manure, Herbal pesticides, insecticides,(i.e. Jivamrut,Dasparni Ark, Compost, Ghan Jivamrut organised in Farmers School{FS} at NETRAVAN.

NiViM working to inculcate the sense of natural resources conservation and management amongst the rural stakeholders by participation of community. Water is very important commodity .In the financial year 2020-2021,NiViM built two Gabian Bandhara on the Nallah already flowing from Khapari to Davha. In the rain of July-2020, more than 15 lacks litre water stored in this bandhara.

NiViM developed and maintaining a natural water hole / streams on the fringe of MCR participation of local farmers .But, most of the time ,their is water scarcity in maximum part of the

forest and farms also. So, to avoid these difficulties .In the summer of May 2021 , A team of NiViM made arrangement of artificial water hole and provide a water by water tanker to quench a thirst of wildlife, cattle and strangers in the vicinity of NETRAVAN. Nisarg Vidnyan Mandal(Organizing activities of informal education through practical to solve an academic educational questions .From last five years an average foot fall per annum at NETRAVAN was 4500 to 5000 persons . But , in the academic year 2020-2021 is decreased due to COVID-19 pandemic impact, Schools ,colleges were closed during lockdown . Due to pandemic , ecotourism and all other places were closed as per Govt. Orders. But, small groups of 10 to 15 persons, one or two families visited to NETRAVAN with maintaining all rules of sanitization, mask and social distance.Mr.Chetan Shrikhande a trained Mountaineer expert conducting all activities of adventures, Nature trails, Nature games, Archeries, Rifle shooting, zip line , Burma bridge commando bridge, body balancing bridge etc.Mr. Dipak Shahu conducting all activities of Natural farming, preparation of herbal insecticides, pesticides, manures etc. Mr.Wasudeo Mohadikar is taking all basic science based experiments,activities from low cost, no cost materials etc.

Prof.Vivek Wagh had been taken classes of maths & English for Z P schools students at tribal village Jambhlapani, Ta Umred, Dist .Nagpur during COVID-19 pandemic situation .Because most of the parents doesn't have mobile for online and proper network also.

NiViM is working voluntarily for implementation of Government programmes in the community very force fully to get successive impact of rural development. NiViM followed a most ambitious project of notification of Muniya Reserve Forest (MRF) a corridor for wildlife movement as a Muniya Conservation Reserve (MCR) since 2007. To get successive participation of community from 30 villages located on the fringe of MRF.NiViM organised lot of activities in association with line departments in general and forest department in particular.The regular and coordination between community members and forest department to get a status of MCR by NiViM. On Dec,4th 2020 ,State Wildlife Board sanctioned a proposal of MRF and notified an area of 9601 Hac(i.e.96.01 Sq. Km) as a Muniya Conservation Reserve(MCR). It is 9th Conservation reserve in Maharashtra and 3rd in Vidarbha.

This one most important success story of NiViM activism for conservation of wildlife , protection forest with community participation. This mile stone in the field of forest conservation inspiring the all team members and community leader from this vicinity to work together for sustainable development of this area. The next step will be publication of this notification in Govt Gazette . After the publication management action will be carried out for over all development of villages on the fringe and growth of flora, fauna,avifauna in the vicinity forest and agriculture also.
